Dear Mr. Harris:

I have your letter of August 22d, and since writing you I have received the three deeds which were completely executed and which I left for recording.

I have not yet had an opportunity to see Mr. Hedden since his return, but I expect to be with him in a day or so, and we shall then proceed with the plans for the formation of the suggested corporation. We have a stock form of corporate powers here which we thought was fairly inclusive, but after investigation we have concluded that it will be necessary to add to it in order to include the operation of a poultry farm and the maintenance of a standing army. Notwithstanding the present uncertainty concerning embargoes, I think we ought to include authority to engage in all kinds of commerce with the Ethiopians!

I shall report to you as soon as I have conferred with Mr. Hedden.
