Right on the site of the old Remain Beamish property (prior to which it was Dauphinee and prior to that it was McGinnis property)

Dan and Janie both say the man to the knemumex treasure is buried on Oak Island. And the treasure is still there. We'll live to see it uncovered.

Dan loves boating and fishing. Janie hates it. They have three children and three grandchildren. plan en a family reunion in Oak Island some day. Three kids: David and two daughters, linda and ?.
