Notes on conversation with dan blankenship at his house Sept. 16, 1976.

Shows me letter dated Sept. 9, 1976, from a Paul Deardorff
1128 Dix Avenue
Lincoln Park, Michigan

who describes himself as a "psychogeologist" and says he knows the location of 10 treasure deposits on Oak Island and that they were put there over a period of years starting in 1623 by **Examinate** Spaniards and that the treasure originated from Brazil.

Dan says this guy's theory ties in with his own; both the dating of the deposit, and the fact that it's Spanish treasure and in ten locations.

Dan doesn't plan to answer the letter as he gets "many many like them".

This Deardorff got his info about Oak Island from a friend, Robert Cook, who visited the island this past August. (Is this the same Cook who now lives in Ottawa???)

Dan describes the time when Dan Henskee *****
"went crazy" on the island and was "rolling around on the floor and screaming". After he came to, Henskee said he had just gone through the death of someone who was currently buried down in the cavity in 10-X. This person is presumably hanging there with his throat cut.

Dan says Ben Webster "who is normally very cautious and skeptical" once interviewed a woman psychic who "told him things that were very spooky". She held some of the metal retrieved from 10-X in her kan hand and had a whole story about men dying down in that hole and a vast treasure still there. She apparently got "impolses" from the metal.
