MEMORANDUM

Please note that the illustrations on page 47 of the 1958 edition of R.V. Harris's "The Oak Island Mystery" and on page 70 of the 1967 edition are inscriptions carved on a large rock near the mouth of the Gaspereau River, Guysborough County. The inscription is evidently not an authentic Kidd inscription. On August 27th, 1969, Miss ^{H?} Mattie Densmore of Halifax reported to me that James S. MacDonald, former President of the Nova Scotia Historical Society told her brother that he and a friend had carved the inscription when they were young.
